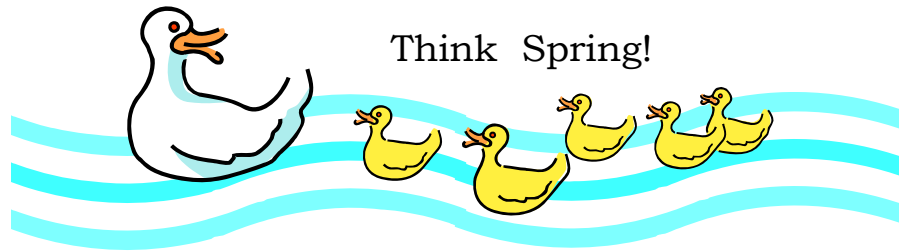
All submissions must be received one month prior to the publication month. The editor reserves the right to edit or shorten items or to postpone article subject to available space.

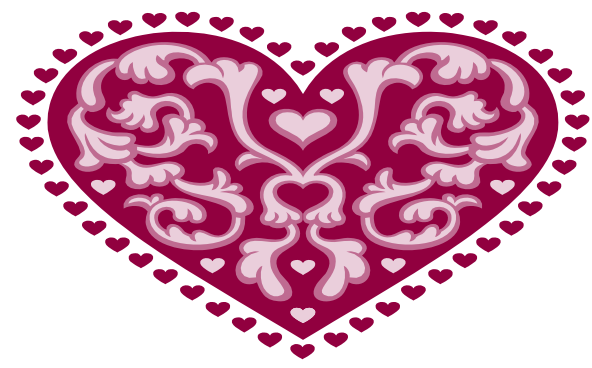

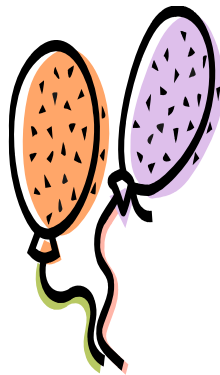
