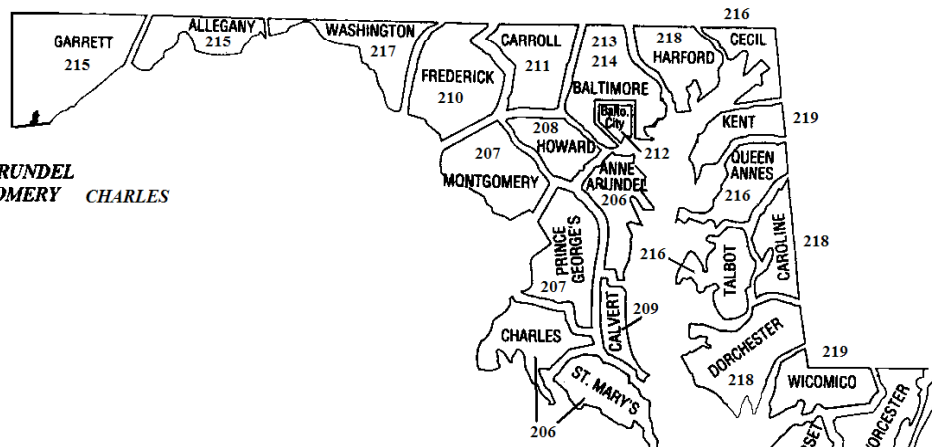

3 Fahrney-Keedy Cooks Graduate from CURA Culinary College

Nancy Burger and Lana Arvin, who are cooks at Fahrney-Keedy, plus Ted Tobia, CDM,CFPP, Director, are among the most recent graduates of CURA Culinary College. They all completed 32 hours of intensive course work over a year's time in Huntingdon, PA.

Ted spoke about the course and its purpose. "It is an outstanding program. It's not just about teaching; it hones the skills that students already have in several areas: the basics of handling knives and kitchen equipment, catering

It's not just about teaching; it hones the skills that students already have in several areas: the basics of handling knives and kitchen equipment, catering displays, salads and cold prep, soups, sauces and gravies, meat and fish, garnishing, and food sanitation. It was intense. On each day of the course, students came ready to work at 8 a.m. and continued until 4 p.m. There was an air of professionalism for the participants that raised the bar on their approach to food preparation." Sessions occurred one day each quarter for a year, at eight hours a day.

The course teaches better ways to prepare certain foods and to work in a kitchen. Techniques learned can then be demonstrated for others on the staff who work in other areas of meal preparation and serving, Ted said. He said he plans to send the other two cooks on the Dietary staff to receive the training.

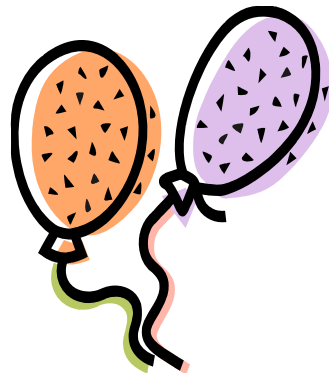
