CE Self-Reporting is Here!

Continuing education (CE) self-reporting is officially here! CDMs are now responsible for tracking their own CE hours and submitting them at the end of their three-year cycle. In short, CDMs will participate in CE activities, record their activity in the CE reporting record, and retain proof of attendance or completion.

Follow one of the two options below to enter CE's or learn how to use CE Self-Reporting.

 Select "Report CE"
 Complete all pertinent fields of your CE activity

All CDMs were mailed the new CBDM Guide to Maintaining Your CDM, CFPP Credential,


which contains step-by-step reporting instructions, CE documentation requirements, and

CDMs should save all CE-related documentation, including certificates of completion, for two three-year certification cycles in case of an audit.
