ANFP conducted surveys in October 2020 and January 2021 delving into the effects COVID-19 has had and continues to have on ANFP members' work environment. Three data points from the surveys are provided below.

Have any foodservice staff been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 30 days? Percentages represent individuals who responded "Yes."

Each work setting reported a much higher level of COVID-19 infection activity among foodservice staff for the prior 30 days in January 2021 versus October 2020.

What are your current dining practices?

Most settings have moved from more restricted In-Room Dining Only settings to Socially Distanced or other less restrictive dining styles in January 2021 compared to October 2020. However, dining styles in Skilled Nursing/Long-Term Care appear to have moved to a more restrictive setting over that same time period as COVID-19 cases have increased.
