Nicole Shiffar, Administrative Assistant LDH –Become engaged in the history of Regional Health Lead-Deadwood Hospital! Established in 1878, the hospital is recognized as the first hospital in the state of South Dakota. Travel through time and tour our lobby/museum of old healthcare artifacts.

Sandra Ogunremi, Regional Health Manager Diversity, Inclusion & Equity – Cultural awareness is one's understanding of the differences between themselves and people from other countries or other backgrounds, especially differences in attitudes and values. The key to cultural awareness is to promote cultural diversity by being nonjudgmental and empathetic toward people from other cultures. The ability to objectively evaluate situations without stereotyping and assumptions helps to promote cultural diversity and heighten cultural awareness.

Leah Braun, Nsight Partners – One of the most powerful ways to improve the workplace is to learn how to identify and focus on priorities more effectively. Participants will learn powerful prioritization and time-management pointers.

Brad Greenway, National Pork Board – Using pig farming as a case study, this presentation demonstrates how traditional farming practices, continuously improved by science-based advancements in agriculture technology, have helped farmers achieve milestones in food animal nutrition and reduce their carbon footprint.

Ryan Betham, CDM, CFPP, ServSafe Instructor – The path that food takes through your operation begins when you buy the food and ends when you serve it. You are responsible for the safety of the food at every point in this flow - and many things can happen to it. The Danger Zone & Time/Temperature control plays a critical role in food safety.

Trina Allen, Regional Health Director of Human Resources Relations & Development – Documentation is both the bane and the blessing for Management and Human Resources. Documentation is what wins, or in some cases loses. The result of lack of documentation is the loss of millions of dollars each year that might be prevented by a good documentation program.

US Foodservice Webinar – Got Ethics? Ethics is knowing the difference between what is right to do and what you have a right to do. Ethical actions are those you can feel good about. What can you do to create or enforce an ethical culture?

Helen Nichols, RD, LN, CDE – Non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD) is one of the most common liver diseases in the world. Adopting a healthy lifestyle is one of the most recommended ways to tackle a fatty liver. As the name implies, the main characteristic of NAFLD is too much fat stored in liver cells. In the United States, it is the most common form of chronic liver disease, affecting about one-quarter of the population.
