

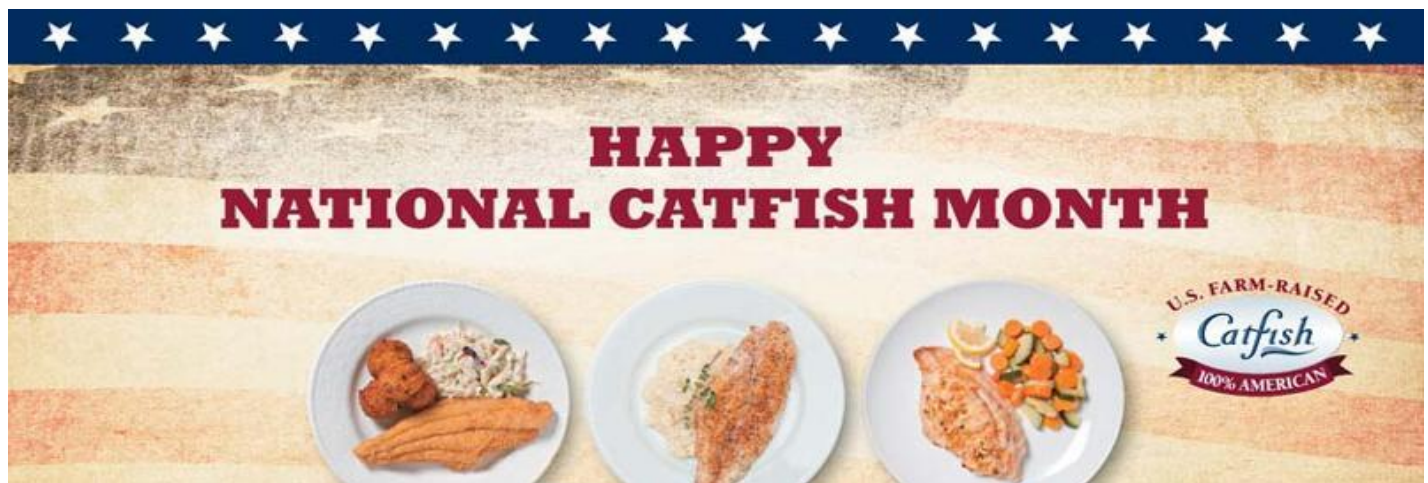
August is National Catfish Month

To honor the hard work and innovations of America's catfish farmers, the month of August was designated by congress as National Catfish Month. Happy Catfish Month!

"August is National Catfish Month, and it's a great opportunity to enjoy the many delicious preparations of our versatile, all-American fish," says Roger Barlow, president of The Catfish Institute. "U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish is embraced across the country not only because of its healthfulness, quality and environmental safety, but also because it is 100-percent American-grown."

U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish is raised in pure freshwater ponds and fed a nutrient-rich diet of floating grain pellets. This extremely eco-friendly farming practice also eliminates the "fishy" taste found in other varieties of fish.

The majority of U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish is produced on family-owned farms in the states of Alabama, Arkansas, Mississippi and Texas, where many of these growers are second- or third-generation catfish farmers. Since the farms and processing plants exist in primarily rural areas, catfish farming provides a significant source of revenue and employment in historically depressed regions of our nation.

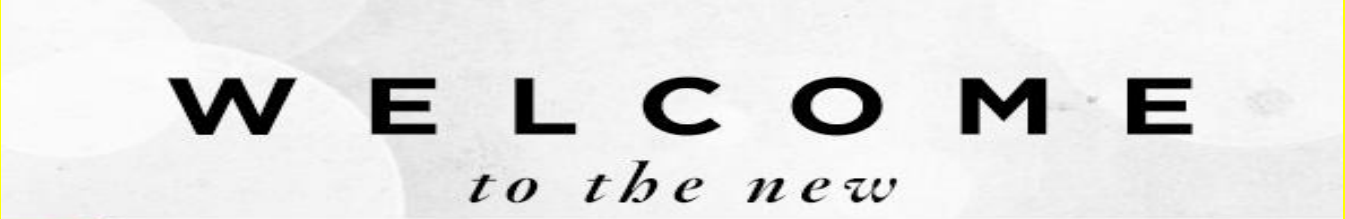

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August is National Peach Month

The peach originated in China and has been cultivated at least since 1000 B.C.E. It has special significance in Chinese culture: the peach has mystical attributes, and supposedly brings luck, abundance and protection.

The peach tree is considered to be the tree of life and peaches are symbols of immortality and unity. Peach blossoms are carried by Chinese brides.

The Romans called the peaches "Persian Apples" naming them after the country that introduced peaches to the West.

Spaniards brought peaches to South America and the French introduced them to Louisiana. The English took them to their Jamestown and Massachusetts colonies. Columbus brought peach trees to America on his second and third voyages.

China is the largest world producer of peaches, with Italy second.

California produces more than 50% of the peaches in the United States (and grows 175 different varieties).
