
ANFP serves as the hub of a national community of professionals who are dedicated to service and excellence in the various aspects of nutrition and foodservice.

CDM, CFPP CREDENTIAL

Earn the CDM, CFPP Credential and Advance Your Career

What is a CDM, CFPP?

A Certified Dietary Manager, Certified Food Protection Professional (CDM, CFPP) has the education, training, and work experience to competently perform the responsibilities of a dietary manager and has proven this by passing the nationally-recognized CDM Credentialing Exam and fulfilling the requirements needed to maintain certified status. A CDM, CFPP also demonstrates specific competence in the areas of foodservice management, personnel and communication, nutrition, sanitation and safety, and business operations.

How to Become a CDM, CFPP

1.

Qualify to take the CDM Credentialing Exam

There are several ways to qualify! You may start by completing an ANFP-approved foodservice manager training program. Or, you may already have a two-year or four-year degree in foodservice management, nutrition, or culinary arts. You may qualify under other pathways that require a combination of education and work experience, including completion of a culinary certificate or military foodservice program supplemented with relevant work experience.

2.

Register for the CDM Credentialing Exam

Offered year-round at more than 300 testing centers, the exam gives you an opportunity to demonstrate your competence in the areas assessed on the exam: www.CBDMonline.org/exam-prep/exam-content-outline.

3.

Pass the Exam & Activate Your Certification

To become certified, you must achieve a passing score on the exam and activate your certification within one year of passing. As an ANFP member, activation is automatic.

Once you earn the credential, you are required to comply with all recertification requirements to maintain use of the credential. This includes completing continuing education as well as paying annual certification fees.

The CDM, CFPP credential is more than the letters after your name. It is a career path that demonstrates your commitment to excellence in nutrition and foodservice management, and identifies you as a highly-qualified professional in your field.

- 3. Are employed at a supervisory level in nutrition and food service

Pre-Professional Membership

For individuals who meet any of the following criteria:

- 1. Employed in nutrition or food service in a non-supervisory role
- 2. Students enrolled in a comprehensive foodservice management training program. Note: Students must include proof of enrollment with their application.
