Dementia. This one really opened my eyes since I come from a hospital and not LTC. The one discussion that really stuck with me was when they demonstrated the proper way to greet a resident with dementia. I have witnessed my dietitian use this skill time from time with some elderly patients at our hospital, but I never knew why until this session. The time and effort caretakers use to make these "scared" individuals feel safe and secure is extraordinary.

The other session that will forever stay with me was given by a man many of you have heard of if you follow the ANFP Connect site. His name is Thom Pastor. He is a CDM, CFPP from Bend, Oregon. He works at his local hospital. He opened his talk with a door cam video and personal story that happened last August. Their door cam recorded the moment he and his wife were leaving for supper. As they were getting into their car, they heard gunfire. They take cover for a moment then instead of going to the restaurant he drove straight to work to help wherever he could. In the days following that evening, one thing he knew for certain in the moment of fear and the unknown was "it was ok to stand there." DON'T JUST DO SOMETHING, STAND THERE was his message. Comfort people. That statement has so much meaning behind it. After waiting to speak with him at the end of his session he handed me a sticker with that message: DON'T JUST DO SOMETHING, STAND THERE. That same sticker hangs in my office today.



We concluded the conference with the Annual Honors Gala. Since we were in New Orleans, the theme was a Masquerade Ball. We were encouraged to dress accordingly for the evening. The evening kicked off with a jazz band, an amazing supper, and the presentation of awards. Iowa won the following awards that evening: Communications Award, Government Affairs Award, Membership Award, Platinum State Achievement Award, and was a Nominee & Finalist for the Diamond Award. We concluded the evening with more music and dancing! The lowa Code for Long Term Care Chapter 58 (58.24(2) Dietary staffing. The facility shall employ dietary staff in accordance with 42 CFR 483.60 (a) recently updated this past year and went to mirror the Center for Medicare/Medicaid Service Mega Rules 2016 language. The Dietary Department changes followed CMS FNS §483.60 Qualifications for the Director of Food and Nutrition Services verbiage so nothing earth shattering other than we no longer have the 24 months for students to complete the CDM coursework, the CDM is still required from the §483.60 and is the first of the 4 listed educational requirements. #### **CMS News**

§483.60 FNS Qualifications for FNS Director Option (E) Has 2 or more years of experience in the position of director of food and nutrition services in a nursing facility setting and has completed a course of study in food safety and management, by no later than October 1, 2023, that includes topics integral to managing dietary operations including, but not limited to, foodborne illness, sanitation procedures, and food purchasing/receiving; and expires on October 1 2023 and is no longer an approved education path.

## **Iowa ANFP Certification Exam Scholarship**
