FDA Food Code Full Version was due to be published in 2021 but has been postponed so yet to be determined

CMS Proposed Rule Changes from 2019 has been withdrawn so the CDM requirement is still intact and remains as is from the Long Term Care Mega Rules published back in 2016. See below!

State Operations Manual (SOM) Appendix PP Guidance to Surveyors for Long Term Care Facilities

§483.60(a)(2) If a qualified dietitian or other clinically qualified nutrition professional is not employed full-time, the facility must designate a person to serve as the director of food and nutrition services who—

- (A) A certified dietary manager; or
- (B) A certified food service manager; or
- (C) Has similar national certification for food service management and safety from a national certifying body; or
- D) Has an associate's or higher degree in food service management or in hospitality, if the course study includes food service or restaurant management, from an accredited institution of higher learning;

Those Food Service Managers hired prior to Nov. 28, 2016 had 5 years (Nov. 28, 2021) to become qualified and that was extended under COVID ENDS April 15, 2022.




