

WE are sharing volunteer opportunities for members of Idaho ANFP to help revitalize and reorganize our chapter. If you are willing to help or lead in any of these areas please contact our President. Thank you so much.

- We want to <u>reactivate our monthly lunch meeting in Boise for members.</u> This group has not met for about 3 years. They met at IHOP in Boise. This will be an opportunity to network and earn 1 CEU each month.
 We need a coordinator and 1-2 people to help organize.


