WHEREAS, the Association of Nutrition and Foodservice Professionals (ANFP) is the leading organization certifying dietary managers in America and Idaho; and

WHEREAS, Idaho ANFP is holding a statewide conference at SYSCO in Boise, Idaho, on April 13-14, 2023, with Certified Dietary Managers from hospitals, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and other facilities from across Idaho; and

WHEREAS, the Idaho ANFP Chapter will be celebrating its 45th Anniversary on Friday, April 14, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Certified Dietary Managers work to provide healthy nutritious meals to the residents, patients, and clients across the state every day; and

WHEREAS, Certified Dietary Managers deal with complex dietary issues, nutrition requirements, and food sanitation and safety; and
