ANFP DIAMOND AWARD

The **ANFP Diamond Award** is presented each year at **ACE** (Annual Conference & Expo) — ANFP's highest chapter honor, for a chapter that "exemplifies dedication to members through chapter initiatives and enthusiastic leadership." **Idaho's 2026 application featured our founding and leadership of Nutrition Day at the Capitol, involving 15 nutrition focused Idaho groups.** During ACE 2026, thirteen chapters were named nominees — **including Idaho** — which was also one of the six finalists. The award was presented to the Georgia Chapter.

Our chapter will plan activities and projects this coming year to apply for the Diamond Award again, and we welcome member ideas. To qualify, chapters must have met the following criteria:

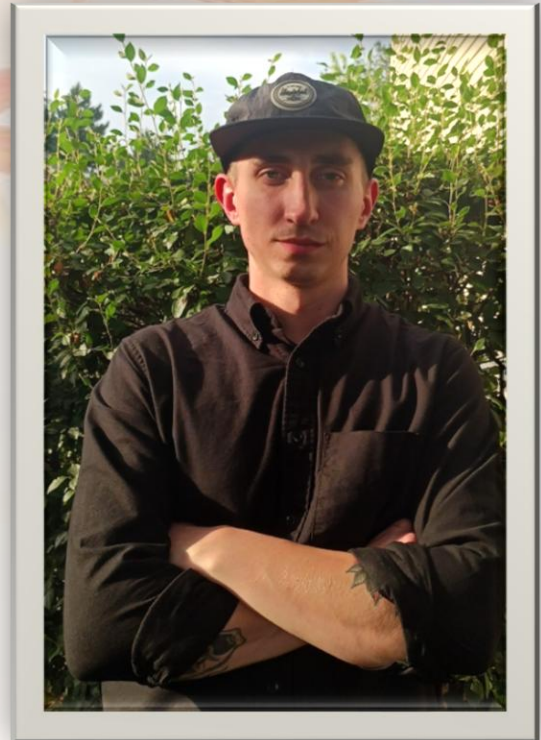
