WHEREAS, March is National Nutrition Month; and

WHEREAS, Idahoans are encouraged to become concerned about their nutrition and become more aware of nutrition efforts across Idaho through long-term healthcare and other facilities and programs across Idaho; and

WHEREAS, nutrition groups from across Idaho are gathering at the Idaho Capitol on Wednesday, March 6, 2024, to highlight the importance of nutrition in the lives of all Idahoans and participate in "NUTRITION DAY at the Idaho Capitol."

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRAD LITTLE, Governor of the State of Idaho, do hereby proclaim March 6, 2024, to be

NUTRITION DAY

in Idaho, and I encourage Idaho citizens to recognize this special observance.
