WE are sharing volunteer opportunities for members of Idaho ANFP to help revitalize and reorganize our chapter. If you are willing to help or lead in any of these areas please contact our President. Thank you so much.

- We want to **reactivate our monthly lunch meeting in Boise for members.** This group has not met for about 3 years. They met at IHOP in Boise. This will be an opportunity to network and earn 1 CEU each month. We need a coordinator and 1-2 people to help organize.
- 2. In the past we have been active with **community service** at our conferences. We have conducted a food drive, toy drive or coat drive to help the less fortunate in the state. We need a leader and 1-2 people to help.
- 3. We want to activate a **Membership Committee** - to maintain communication with members, recruit new members, send out birthday cards to members, etc. We could conduct a membership drive across the state. We need a leader and 1-2 helpers.
- 4. Committee Member- assist the leader of our Government Affairs Committee and works to establish and maintain communication with local, state and federal elected officials from Idaho. We want to keep them informed of ANFP and the role of CDM's across our state. We need 1-2 helpers. We could organize an ANFP Day At The Capitol in Boise.
- 5. **CDM Student Outreach** - we need a leader and a helper to work with CDM students across Idaho and to establish communication to encourage them becoming pre-professional and then active ANFP members. We currently have students with the Idaho Health Care Association and online students with the University of North Dakota.
- **Chapter Historian** we need a leader and a helper to maintain our chapter storage unit in Meridian and to maintain records of our activities and history.
- 7. **Fundraising** we need a leader and 1-2 helpers to organize fundraising activities at our conferences and for special events to help raise funds for the chapter. This could be conference drawings, fundraising events, etc.
- 8. **Presenters** we need presenters for our conferences and the monthly luncheon in Boise. If you have a special skill or area of interest - or know someone who does.. we would love to hear from you. In the future, we could add other areas for a monthly luncheon if there is enough interest and someone is willing to organize and lead.
