BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ILANFP NOMINATING POSITIONS:

President-Elect Attend and present requested reports/copies at all Board and Business meetings and special meetings/conference calls. Assumes responsibilities of President in his or her absence. Serves as Nominating Committee Chair.

Treasurer Responsible for the financial affairs of the chapter: develop and maintain a budget, review and maintain financial reports, complete required IRS forms, Chair Finance Committee.

Treasurer-Elect assists Treasurer, assumes responsibilities of Treasurer in absence and may become Treasurer when that position is open; performs specific duties delegated by Treasurer Volunteer Coordinator/Trainer has a working knowledge of officer and Committee Chair/Co-Chair duties/tasks; trains newly elected Board members with job duties/tasks prior to their installation. Assists all Board Members to know their responsibilities and complete their tasks.

Program Meeting/Speakers Chair Responsible for: obtaining speaker bios and objectives; format meeting agenda, registration form and evaluation form; submit CBDM prior approval form for educational sessions; plan Chapter meetings.

Membership Chair Contact new, potential, dropped members, students, and newly certified members; evaluate current membership retention and recruitment strategy, submit the Membership Award if applies.

Newsletter Editor/Webmaster Chair Create a professional publication to be distributed to Chapter membership at least twice yearly; Submit Communications Award if applies; Submit update requests to ANFP Chapter Relations; Submit up to thirty photos per Chapter event to be posted.

Vendor/ Expo Chair Responsible for overseeing Chapter's Expo; solicit booths and sponsorships; complete a list of potential venders from ILANFP members and ANFP.

Ways and Means Chair Responsible for organizing approved Ways and Means projects for the general and or travel fund; give monies from approved projects to Chapter Treasurer.

Meeting Logistic Chair Must work a year ahead for planning/securing locations and dates for meetings; arrange for adequate: auto visual and technology according to program needs, space for vendor booths; appropriate sleeping rooms for attendees; menus for meals, beverages, snacks and special events; complete contracts as needed.
