Martha is a former Indiana ANFP Administrator of the Year and her passion on professional ethics was the inspiration of ANFP to require Ethics as a part of the 3 year CE requirement. Barbara Minger RD will be doing session on memory care and the evolving definition of health. Tom Thaman and Bob Milligan will be hosting a session on leadership and leadership styles and Tom Thaman will be presenting on continuing competency.
