

Meet Anthony Neimeyer CDM, CFPP—From Student to CDM to Retail Supervisor in One Year by Tom Thaman, CDM, CFPP

In each Newsletter we like to feature a story or two on Indiana ANFP members. Every CDM has a journey to share but we sometimes overlook our new members and would like to introduce them to the Indiana ANFP members. This month, I would like to introduce Anthony Neimeyer, CDM, CFPP. I have known Anthony for about a year and am thrilled to share his story because he has joined our team as a Retail Supervisor at Eskenazi Health.

Anthony has an varied background. He was born in Hawaii and considers himself an "Air Force brat" and did a tour in the Navy stationed on the west coast. He eventually made his way to Indianapolis where he worked a variety of jobs including a Starbucks store supervisor. Along the way, he met his significant other, Natasha and they became first time parents in December of last year to a little girl they named Ophellia



We first met Anthony as a student at Ivy Tech in Indianapolis where he was completing his coursework for the Dietary Managers program. Part of that program consists of 150 hours of onsite intern experience which we host at Eskenazi. I was Anthony's main preceptor. We had two to three week rotations in Production, Retail, Patient Service and Sanitation. Anthony did and outstanding job in every area he worked and projects he was assigned. He completed his rotation in November of 2020. What was very

obvious during his internship was that Anthony had an exception technical skill set and could navigate any soft ware program or app that we had available in the department. At my urging Anthony became a student member of ANFP which would elevate him to CDM status once he passes the exam. Anthony graduated from Ivy Tech in December of 2020 and in February of this year we had a retail supervisory position open up at Eskenazi and because the management team knew his skills from his rotation, he was our top candidate, starting the position in March. Anthony applied for a scholarship to take the exam through the NFEF and passed the exam and became a CDM, CFPP in May of this year.

Anthony is a certified personal trainer which peaked his interest in nutrition ultimately leading him to the Dietary Managers coursework at Ivy

Tech Anthony long range goal is to become a Registered Dietitian. The wit future looks bright for Anthony and look forward to his continued career growth!!

The Importance of the Booster Shot




It is hard to believe by we are almost at two years into the Pandemic with no signs of it letting up anytime soon. While we are going through the second wintertime surge, as CDM, CFPP, it is important that we continue to recommend to our team to get the booster shot that is now available through most vaccine providers. Trial studies have shown that the initial two step vaccination shot effectiveness are reduced when the second shot was given more than six month ago. The effectiveness for the shot for the Delta variant to avoid a severe infection and hospitalization is at 70%. The booster shot increases the protection by 90% for an infection for the Delta variant and almost 100% against hospitalization of the Omicron variant.

While there are breakthrough infections, there are usually underlying causes such as congestive heart failure or diabetes or other life threatening causes such as cancer or liver disease. The late General Colin Powell who recently passed away from CoVid had by also had been diagnosed with Melanoma and he was fully vaccinated. It does happen but is rare.

Continue to keep your staff informed and encourage them to seek the booster shot if eligible. If your facility does not require a mandatory vaccination yet, keep encouraging your team to get vaccinated. It could save their life! Below is the current data from the CDC as of December 13, 2021 on the state of vaccination in America. Please continue to "mask up" and practice social distancing. WE are NOT done with his thing yet!!
