On March 7 we had our Day at the Capitol. Thank you to Leonard Turpen, and Jennifer Harris for attending with me.

I feel we had a successful day. We had several meetings that day including Rep. Ron Ellis, Senator Brenda Deitrich, Rep. Brenda Landwehr, and her assistant David Long. We had good visits with the office managers for Rep. Jason Goetz Rep. Scott Hill, Rep. Leah Howell, Rep. Bill Rhiley, and Sen. Elaine Bowers. We were able to leave materials with them to pass on for us.

We had good conversations at each visit. Some of the topics of conversation included Medicaid expansion, funding for LTC, and the need for increased mental health resources in Kansas. One topic each of them also shared a concern about was the end of emergency SNAP benefits and how it will affect our seniors. Senator Deitrich shared that it is too late to address this in this session, however, she shared what would be needed to write up a bill to present in next session to address this.

Rep. Brenda Landwehr is Chair of the House Committee on Health and Human Services. We had a lengthy discussion with her assistant David Long before she was able to join us. He gave information on who to contact on KanCare Oversight Committee. This committee handles the budget for SNAP benefits. I was also given information on how to reach Gary Deeter, Committee Assistant for Welfare Reform Committee. There is a meeting on April 21 and we may be asked to give testimony on behalf of our elders on how this affects them with limited resources, income, and abilities.

Overall I believe we had a successful DAC and have many leads to follow up on.

I had car trouble for a while so I have not completed visiting with the culinary class at Labette County High School. However, I will get with the instructor and set a date for this.

I am on Legislative Committee. We have just approved a PAC donation for Senator Bill Cassidy. We are inviting him to attend ACE conference in Louisiana this summer.

Due to the holidays it has been a bit slow, however, I am looking forward to being quite busy in the months to come.

Latest Regulatory Updates from the Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS)

In 2019, CMS proposed changing the regulations regarding the qualifications for Directors of Food and Nutrition Services to allow a director to either have two years of experience working in that position, or have completed a minimum course of study in food safety. ANFP, its members, and other organizations submitted comments to CMS in support of keeping the education requirements as originally written in 2016. §483.60 11.28.2016 - In the absence of a full time dietitian, a Director of Food and Nutrition Services was required to be **A)** Certified Dietary Manager, Certified Food Protection Professional (CDM, CFPP) **B)** a Certified Food Manager, **C)** have a similar certification in food service management and safety, or **D)** have an Associate's Degree or higher in foodservice management or hospitality.

Fast forward to August 2022, CMS LTC SNFs Final Rule was combined with 2019's proposed rule, and PPS [CMS-1765-F] 08.03.2022 §483.60 Food and Nutrition Services was posted. An additional educational option was added that was to help with the original 2016 five-year clause that ended under COVID-19 on November 21 that gave those working as the Director prior to 2016 with two years or more experience the opportunity to obtain one of the education options A, B, C or D. Here is the latest 2022 option: **E) Has two or more years of experience in the position of Director of Food and Nutrition Services in a nursing facility setting and has, by no later than October 1, 2023, completed a course of study in food safety and management**

that includes topics integral to managing dietary operations including, but not limited to, foodborne illness, sanitation procedures, and food purchasing/receiving.

The new qualification requirements cannot be met by having taken a course of study alone but must be **accompanied by two years of experience as the Director of Food and Nutrition Services.**

The good news, that we as ANFP members and CDM, CFPPs can be pleased to see is, the CDM, CFPP credential remains listed first in the regulatory language. Option E has a limited "shelf life" for one year ending October 2023, and like the others B, C, and D, does not have it in their scope of practice to participate in the care planning process. This is another "win" for CDM, CFPPs, yet another compelling reason being a CDM, CFPP makes us a valuable Interdisciplinary Team member in our care communities - because our scope of practice enables us to be a part of the care planning process.

Don't let this new option distract you! Be proud of the credential you have earned and continue to encourage others to join us and become experts in foodservice management and food safety, and part of the cornerstone of the collaborative food and nutrition profession.
