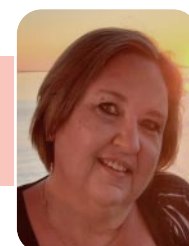
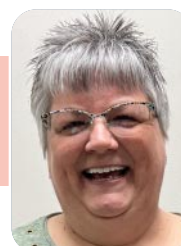

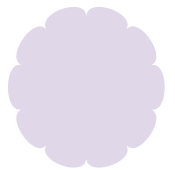
We are always looking for new vendors to add to the mix. We had a couple new vendors at the Fall Workshop in Lawrence and want to thank everyone that participated.

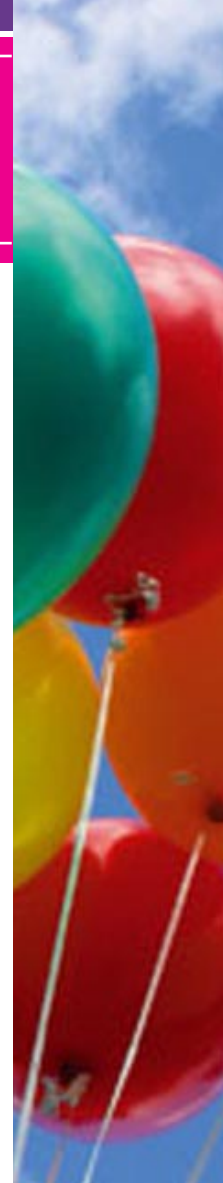

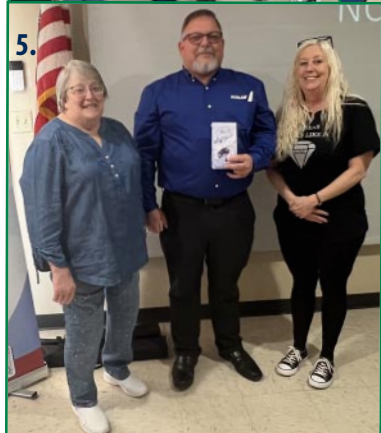
