End date must be January 1, 2022 or later. Verifiable documentation is required, including some from the organization for which the role was served. A maximum of 2 CE may be accrued per year, with a total of 6 C in a three-year recertification period. CE will not be awarded until date of service ends.

To access you must log in and go to profile>My Certification> Self Reporting> scroll down to Report CE button then scroll down to Volunteer Leadership button and then Report Activity - follow directions.


