Holiday recipes

Pecan Cheesecake Pie

INGREDIENTS

1 unbaked pie crust 1 8 oz package cream cheese 1/4 c. sugar 4 eggs, divided 1 tsp vanilla 1 c. chopped pecans 1 c. corn syrup 1/4 c. packed brown sugar

DIRECTIONS

Beat cream cheese, sugar, 1 egg and vanilla until smooth. Spread evenly in pie shell. Sprinkle pecans over top of cheese layer. Beat remaining 3 eggs, corn syrup and brown sugar together well. Pour evenly over pecans. Bake at 425 for 10 minutes, then reduce heat to 375 and bake for another 25-30 minutes or until set and golden. Allow to cool and enjoy!

Everyones Favorite Cranberry Salad - Debbie Gohl

INGREDIENTS

1 ¾ cup boiling water
 2 3oz raspberry jello
 14 oz cranberry sauce, whole or jellied
 8 oz crushed pineapple, undrained
 1 small can mandarin oranges, drained and chopped

DIRECTIONS

Add boiling water to gelatin, stir until dissolved, about 2 minutes. Stir in the cranberry sauce. Add pineapple and oranges. Refrigerate until thickened, about 30 minutes. At this point, you can add nuts if you choose. Pour into a 9"x 13" pan and refrigerate until set. You can serve it with a dollop of mayonnaise, stir in some mini marshmallows, or my favorite: stir in 8 oz of cool whip Or spread it on the top like frosting. Makes 12 servings.

DIRECTIONS

- Cook 8 pieces of bacon, then chop and set aside for later
- Grease 9x13 dish

• Use 2 tubes of crescent rolls fold following package direction. Place in greased dish side by side

Mix

- 5 beaten eggs
- 1 cup milk
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 6 green onions chopped
- 1/2 t. Kosher salt
- 1 t. pepper

Fold in

- 2 cups shredded chedder cheese and chopped bacon
- Pour over crescents rolls

Bake 375 for 25 minutes till crescents are light brown and egg mixture is set (Note: for institutional servings it will take close to an hour plus to get done). Our residents loved these, Enjoy!

Kansas Bread

Stuffing - Leonard Turpen



INGREDIENTS

Onion, Yellow Fresh, small dice I small Butter 1/2 stick of butter Celery, Diced Fresh 3 ribs Bread, White Sliced, diced or torn 1 lb Parsley, Fresh, chopped fine ½ oz Sage, Rubbed Dried ½ tsp Thyme, Dried, Ground 2 /8 tsp Marjoram, Ground Dry 2 /8 tsp Pepper, White Ground 2 /8 tsp Salt, lodized 1 tsp Homemade rich Chicken Stock 1 pint

Variations: May use half cornbread instead of all white bread (let dry 2 days) Pan Size: 6x8 casserole

DIRECTIONS

Saute onions and celery butter, until tender but not brown out cool and add herbs. Cut bread in small cubes or break/tear by hand the day before, and let air dry over night Combine bread and vegetables until well mixed, I like to add one egg to cooled stock Add the stock a little at a time until moist but not soggy. Adjust seasoning. Place in a greased bake pan and bake at 350, 45-60 minutes until temps at 190 for 15 sec. Serves 12

DIRECTIONS



- 1 cup oleo Cream thoroughly Add:
- 2 beaten eggs Cream again

• 1 cup sour cream - Mix together Add:

- 1t. Baking soda
- 1t. Baking powder Mix Add:
- 1 1/2 t. Pure vanilla Mix

Add: 4 1/2 cups of flour to start

Then put on table and fold in more flour to make soft ball. (Not stiff or cookies will be dry)

Roll out and cut

Bake at 375 degrees until BOTTOM of cookies are light brown. Approximately 10 to 12 minutes

Butter cream frosting recipe

- 2/3 cup shortening
- 1/3 cup butter(softened) Cream Add:
- 1 to 2 T. Milk
- 2t. Pure vanilla
- 1t. Almond extract
- 1T. Butter flavoring

Approximately 4 to 6 cups powder sugar


