President's Message, Winter's End/Early Spring 2022





David Parker, CDM, CFPP

David has been a CDM, CFPP since 2018. David has been working for Sodexo for 26 years, most recently as a CDM and General Manager at the Hebrew Home, Homecrest House in Washington, DC.

Question: David, with everything going on: Supply Chain issues, Cost of Food, and Labor Shortages, how are you keeping it all together?

I know the name of each staff member's kids and even know if they have a special occasion such as an anniversary, kids birthday and what college or school they go to. 
