DID YOU KNOW?

Good morning Chapter Leaders,

As we approach chapter spring meetings, whether virtual or in person, we wanted to remind our chapters of communications regarding CE providers and CE hours. While our CE providers have been approved by the CBDM to provide CE credits through their educational programs, that approval does not imply any specific endorsement by ANFP CBDM or its chapters. Additionally, we as ANFP nor chapters, cannot guarantee CE hours for our members. Rather, we should inform members they can earn a maximum number of hours based on the approved CEs being offered for a program.

We kindly ask you to inform members as an ANFP affiliate, we do not and cannot endorse CE providers. We also need to explain to members that they can earn up to the specified amount of hours but hours are not guaranteed; it is incumbent upon the credential holder to complete the CE activity and submit required documentation.

CDM, CFPP Recertification Policy

The CBDM made a policy change in January, 2019, requiring all CDM, CFPPs to meet all CE requirements (45 total continuing education hours, including 9 Sanitation/Safety CE hours and 1 Professional Ethics CE hour) by May 31 of the last year of their recertification period. Individuals not meeting this requirement would have their CDM, CFPP credential terminated. This policy was to be implemented as of May 31, 2020. (From ANFP eNews)

ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION

CDM, CFPPs who were to recertify on May 31, 2020, were given an extension due to the COVID 19 Pandemic. This automatically puts any member who did not have their total 45 hours into the audit process. When a member is placed in the audit process, they are notified through email. The member has the responsibility to respond for information requirements to be met. Should the member fail to meet the required deadlines of the audit, he/she loses his/her certification.

ALL communications will be sent to your email address in your membership file with National ANFP. It is very important and members' responsibility to keep email addresses current.

CDM, CFPPs recertifying on May 31, 2021, were not given an extension. You must have all your required 45 CEs.
