The North Carolina Association of Nutrition and Foodservice Professionals (NC ANFP) was established in 1969, marking 56 years of service. Originally formed as a chapter of the Hospital, Institution, and Educational Food Service Society (HEFSS), the organization traces its roots back to 1960. HEFSS was founded under the umbrella of the American Dietetic Association (ADA), with a small office space in the ADA's national headquarters in Chicago.

The national executive board comprised elected officers from the general membership, alongside Registered Dietitians who served in an advisory capacity. The President and Chair of the Board were elected members of the association, reflecting the organization's member-led governance structure

In 2018 NC ANFP received the highly prestigious Diamond Award at ANFP's Annual Conference & Expo. The award recognizes one standout state chapter each year for excellence in leadership, education, community impact, and innovative best practices—like their app and fundraising events benefiting Camp Cocoon.
