Monday, December 7th, is National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day, or as it is more commonly called, Pearl Harbor Day.

This is a day designated to remember the surprise attack on the United States at Pearl Harbor, by Japanese forces on December 7th, 1941.

In that attack, 2,403 American service members and civilians were killed, and 1,178 were injured. Nearly 20 American naval vessels were destroyed or damaged, including eight battleships. Over 300 planes were destroyed or damaged.

The day after the attack, President Roosevelt asked Congress to declare war on Japan, which was done. Italy and Germany then declared war on the United States. The United States was now involved in World War II.

While we have very few World War II veterans alive today in our country,

I ask you to join me in remembering the lives lost at Pearl Harbor, and all of the lives lost during World War II. Also, to honor our World War II veterans, and those who lived during that war.
