Who is the real St. Patrick?

Patrick was born in Britain of a Romanized family. When he was 16 years old, Irish • raiders tore him from the villa of his father, Calpurnius, a deacon and minor local official, and carried Patrick into slavery in ٠ Ireland. He spent six bleak years there as a herdsman, during which time he turned • with fervor to his faith. Upon dreaming • that the ship in which he was to escape was ready, he fled his enslaver and found ٠ passage to Britain. There he came near to starvation and suffered a second brief • captivity before he was reunited with his family. Thereafter he may have paid a short visit to the Continent. •

What about Easter, Why is it called Easter?

St. Bede the Venerable, the 6th-century author of *Historia ecclesiastica gentis Anglorum* ("Ecclesiastical History of the English People"), maintains that the English word "Easter" comes from *Eostre*, or *Eostrae*, the Anglo-Saxon goddess of spring and fertility. Other historians maintain the "Easter" derives from *in albis*, a Latin phrase that's plural for *alba*, *or* "dawn," that became *eostarum* in Old High German, a precursor to the English language of today.

Despite its significance as a Christian holy day, many of the traditions and symbols

that play a key role in Easter observances actually have roots in pagan celebrations particularly the pagan goddess Eostre and in the Jewish holiday of <u>Passover</u>.
