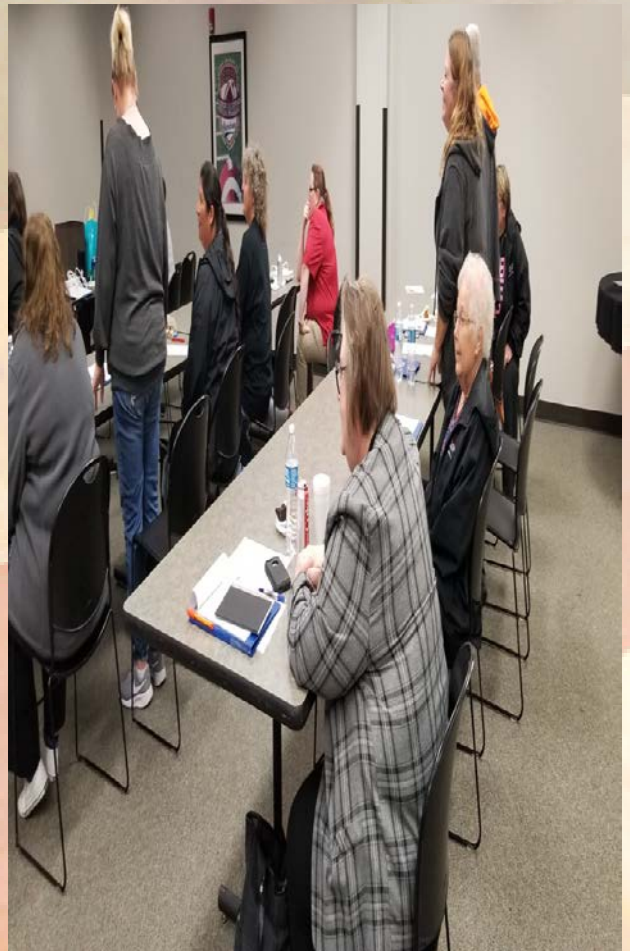

This is Daniel Pae, he is our newly elected House of Representative. He is excited about his new journey for our state. He is personable and easy to talk to. He is down earth and wants to help wherever he can. One of his challenges he see is that there are many newly elected offices this year, 46 in fact, 75% of the legislature has 2 years or less experience . He stated, "on paper it can seem concerning, but having met a lot of these men and women that have been elected I'm very encouraged, they are driven to tackle the issues of this state and move this state forward". He will be serving on a couple new boards, one is the veteran's committee and the other is the government efficiently committee. Some of his goals are to work with ODVA on getting the gold star spouses and the widow of a soldier killed in action tax exempt status. Also, work with the teachers and school board to be able to identify human trafficking in the schools. When I asked how he felt about how our older generation is being taken care of, he said he volunteers at a local nursing home and can see that a lot of improvement needs to be done. He stated, " we need to keep in mind that our patients are first and foremost". He is focusing on groups that target our older generation and take advantage of them. We visited about the role Certified Dietary Manger play in the life of the patient/resident. I explained the role of the ANFP and its goals. I spoke to him about the pay some of the CDM's make, and that we felt they need more pay for what they do. I told him we help sustain someone's life, and some get paid less then someone flipping burgers. He stated that unfortunately there had been some budget cuts over the years, but hoping for a better future. That the state is in the black for the first time in a decade. He also stated that we cannot fight everything at one time, "we have to take everything slow to make sure it is done right the first time", he said. He stated he hopes to help turn things around in Oklahoma. I believe he is going to be a great an asset to the state ok Oklahoma.
