

- Applicant must provide payment receipt for National Convention Registration or for course or books if awarded the scholarship.
- Applicant must be willing to submit a newsletter article on the experience, and an article summarizing what was learned. (If used for nationals)
- Applicant must attend the formal awards banquet to represent our state. (If used for nationals)

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Please only include information that has been requested.

- Answer every space on the Scholarship Application
- VT ANFP preserves the right to disperse financial assistance as is feasible, application does not imply acceptance.

SELECTION PROCESS

The VT ANFP Executive Board will review all applications and determine which applicant will receive the \$275.00 early bird Registration fee. One scholarship will be given each year to one applicant for Registration for Nationals. They will also discuss and review the application for new student scholarships. DEADLINES
