Happy Spring!!! We are putting the final touches on the ANFP Wisconsin State Spring Conference at the Osthoff Resort on the shores of Elkhart Lake on Thursday April 15 and Friday April 16, 2021. Programs and emailed reminders have been sent out to all members. Please be patient with our team of board members, Speakers & Osthoff Staff as we face the A/V and advanced technology challenges of our first hybrid conference to ensure a meaningful, safe and memorable experience for all attendees. Approved clock hours are finalized at 10.75 clock hours. Surveys and conference CEU certificates will be emailed to all Zoom attending members within 7 days of the conference completion date and in person attendees will receive theirs on Friday 4/16/21 in person. (Please make sure your mailing address and email are correct at ANFPonline by checking your profile as several mailed programs were returned with no forwarding information.

Just a few final reminders....

- Our speakers and members will be maintaining social distancing. Please be respectful of our speakers and other members public spacing comfort level. Conference seating will be limited to two at each 6 table on each end and five foot distancing between rows of tables. Registration table and coffee will require five foot social distancing between attendees and will be marked off with tape.
- The room reservation deadline of March 19, 2021 has passed at the special rate of \$99/night plus tax and room pricing may be subject to regular room rates (\$129-159) and limited availability. Please call the Osthoff to enquire on remaining room availability and pricing.
- Mask use continues to be required in all entry areas, registration, restaurants and bar areas, conference areas and common spaces per Sheboygan County Health Codes. If you are not observed wearing a mask, an Osthoff team member may provide one for you for your use.

- One meal will be provided during the two day conference (boxed lunch on Thursday) which may be enjoyed in the conference meeting room or in your own room, per your preference. Shared F & B and candy is prohibited so please bring a cooler bag or keep your snacks and beverages on your person, in your vehicle or sleeping room for easy access. (A purchased soft drink and water bottle is acceptable in conference rooms) Doug Kreger will be providing complimentary coffee service in the conference room both days so please support his organization and thank him for providing this continued service at our A.N.F.P. Conferences. The Elk Lounge and Otto's restaurant, both located on site, provides a full service menu for meal pickup, room tray delivery or restricted occupancy dine in. Calling in meals in advance is highly recommended as there are other groups using conference facilities the same days in addition to visiting familes and business members. Other restaurants are located within walking distance from the hotel, for easy access.
- Zoom emailed invites for paid online participants will be coming out the first week in April. THE DEADLINE FOR IN PERSON REGISTRATION OR ONLINE ZOOM PARTICIPATION IS April 1, 2021. Paid check or Pay Pal payments must be postmarked to Jon Holfeltz by midnight 4/1/21 to attend. No late registrations will be accepted after April 5, 2021 to ensure guaranteed meal counts and room reservations are communicated and Zoom invites are emailed timely. If you are not able to complete the registration and payment deadlines above, you will not be able to attend. If you are attending via Zoom, please download the Zoom app to your phone, laptop or desktop a week prior to the conference to streamline access the day of the conference. Please and Thank you.

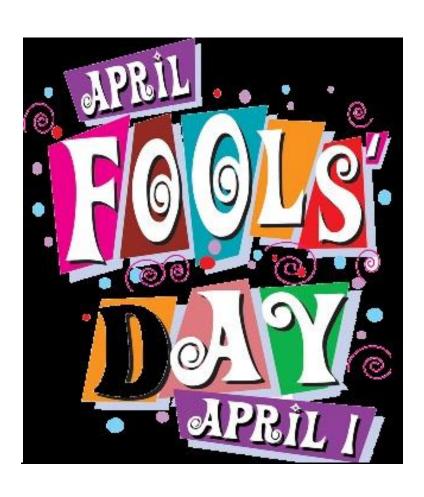

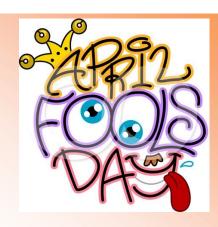
It is beneficial to join coalitions with allied associations.
