Fall meeting Oct. 19-20th 2017 in Morgantown at the Courtyard Marriott- hosted by Bob Luke and Bev Allen

Todd Leasure called the meeting to order and introduced Bob Luke – Secretary and he read the previous meeting minutes from the fall ~~2016~~ meeting, since there was no spring meeting this year. No one expressed concerns after reading minutes. Darlene Schoonover was introduced as our Treasurer and she gave the accounting report of the money in our account as \$19,230.09 which did include some but not all expenditures from this meeting. 45 members total attended the meeting. Todd explained briefly the SWOT analysis that was conducted by National to membership, and introduced our national guest from Kansas (Shawn Williams). Informed membership of the suggestions from National to continue to offer free registration to students, and restarting to offer new CDM to our organization one free registration, and possibly including one night hotel stay. Improving newsletter with new format including photos, continuing to offer Administrator of the year nominations even though participation has been lacking, and new committees to help make our organization stronger and have assistance with some of the board positions

4 students that attended meeting were introduced to membership. They are Dona Rutter, Joyce Dayton, Michele Ash, and Natasha Blankenship.

Members attending were polled as requested to see what percentage of employers are supporting them to attend meetings- Approx. 75-80 % raised their hand that they were being supported by their facility in whole or in part.

Finance committee was developed which need to include 2 board members and 2 regular members: Darlene and Todd from the board, and members included Penny Settle, Sherry Bolton, and Cheryl McHone. They will meet in April of each year and turn in report to the president for June board meetings. They will oversee the banking accounts and expenses occurred at meetings, etc.

Teller : Sandy Shahan- remains on committee and is responsible for counting ballots when needed for board positions, and oversees the voting process mail ins and also live voting at meetings

President Elect position was opened up to membership again since Ray Digman chose to step down.

Eric McClung has decided to be President – Elect and approved by membership present at meeting. He will take over fall 2019 as President and work under Todd for the next 2 years. Todd agreed to do an additional year on his term.

Communication Committee: (Sunshine and Facebook): Ilene Marsh volunteered for the position and we be handling birthday, get well and sympathy cards and keeping our facebook page up to date with photos, job openings etc. Membership was reminded to contact Ilene with anyone that was ill, lost a love one, or has a job opening at their facilities. Ilene's contact info will be in the next newsletter for membership to contact as needed. She told membership that she will donate the cards needed and the board will reimburse her for postage with receipts. Finance committee will approve budget for this as well. Ilene will also be taking pictures at meetings to assist newsletter editor.

Bylaws will be reviewed as needed and discussed possibility of changing terms of President to 1 year rather than 2 which would result in a 3 year commitment rather than 6 years (President Elect/ president/past president).

Bob Luke is continuing to be Secretary until fall 2019, since no one showed interest in the position.

Key Role Committee also developed which will oversee the board and hold them accountable : these members were Brenda Vincent, Dawn Karwacki, and Sandy Martin.

Future meeting host were discussed: Penny Settle is doing the Spring 2018 meeting in Beckley area in April or May; Fall 2018 Dawn Kawacki agreed to host in Ripley/Spencer area, no other future meeting hosts noted.

Membership was given our facebook account: ANFPWVchapter so they can keep up with the organization. Meeting adjourned

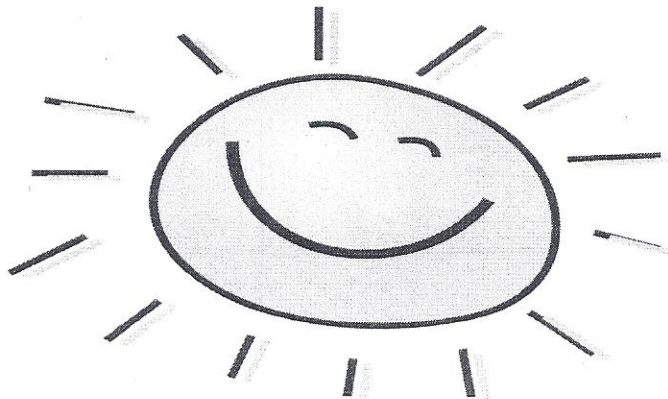

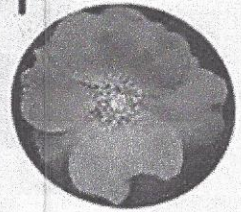
